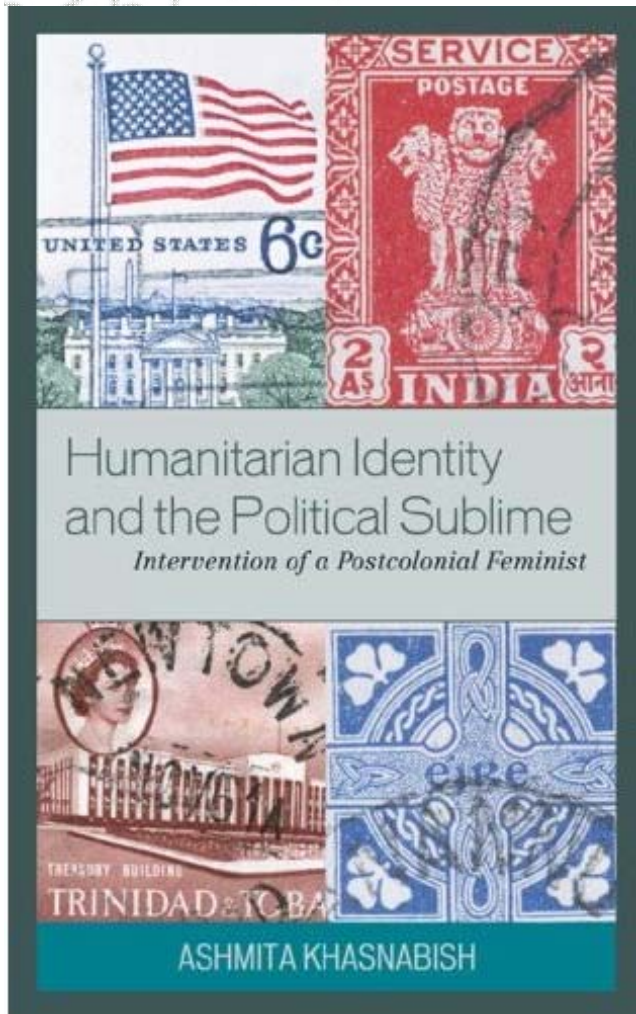


Humanitarian Identity and the Political Sublime
